

30TH STREET MAIN POST OFFICE RECEIVES NATIONAL TRUST PRESERVATION HONOR

The restoration of the 30th Street Main Post Office in Philadelphia was a 2012 National Trust for Historic Preservation Honor Award winner, and a 2011 Philadelphia Preservation Alliance Grand Jury Award Winner. The dynamic team erased 70 years of deterioration, restored many character defining historic aspects of the building and achieved a certification of LEED Gold for the project. The reuse project transformed 900,000 square feet of vacant space into an attractive modern office building, now home to over 5,000 employees.
